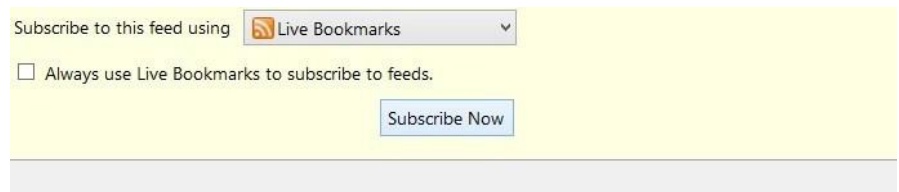


# Setting up a bookmark in Firefox

You can set up a news feed **entry** in the bookmarks toolbar list of the web browser Mozilla Firefox. The easiest way to set it up is to:

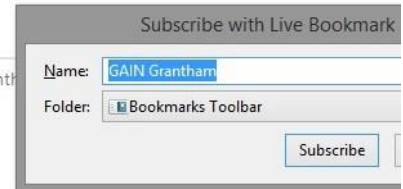
1. Click one of the RSS feed menu options, e.g. **Parents of children**, to display the page.
2. Click the **Subscribe Now** button, and a little window pops up.
3. Click the **Subscribe** button in this little window, and the menu is set up.

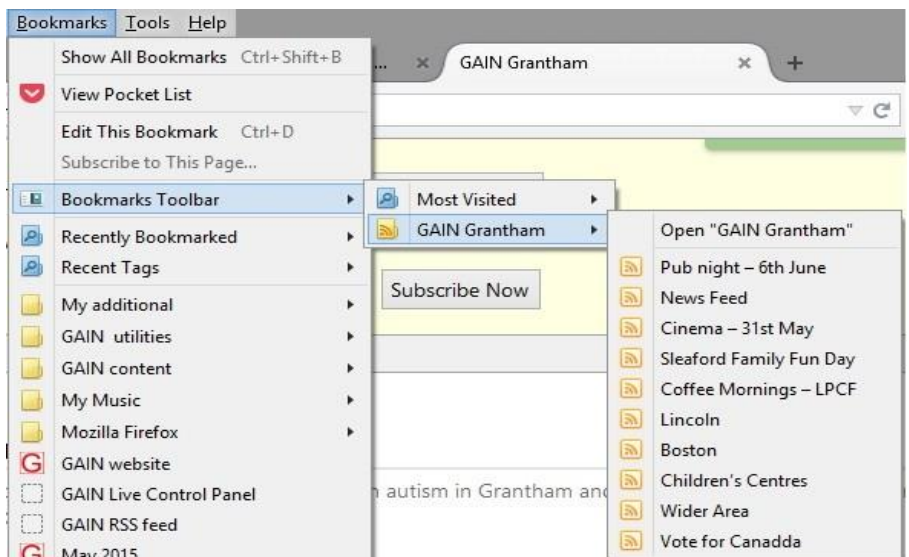

## Using your bookmark menu

1. Now click your **Bookmarks** menu option, then the **Bookmarks Toolbar** option.
2. Hover over the **GAIN Grantham** menu item you have just created, and after a second or two a list of items should appear.
3. If you have chosen a page updates list, e.g. **Parents of children**, hover over an item and you might recognise the path to a **page**. For example:



<http://www.gain-grantham.co.uk/welcome/about-us/>

which would refer to the **Welcome -> About Us** page.

4. If you have chosen **Events** updates, most of the entries will be **posts**, in which case you will see the month in which it was created in the path. For example:

<http://www.gain-grantham.co.uk/2015/05/coffee-may/>

which would refer to the post with the title **Coffee – May** from May 2015.
